

7. Vehicle Width

Course obstacles will be set according to the widest wheel base (+6") of the vehicles entered in the competition on show day. Measurements will be taken the morning of the show.

SAFETY

8. Condition of Harness and Vehicle

In the interest of safety, it is the competitor's responsibility to be certain that the harness is in good repair, and that the vehicle is in sound condition. No competitor will be allowed to continue in a class when, in the opinion of the Judge any part of the turnout has become dangerous or unsafe. No stone boats allowed.

Any style of harness is acceptable, as long as it is properly fitted and in good condition.

9. NO CANTERING OR GALLOPING WILL BE ALLOWED IN ANY CLASS. ONLY EXCEPTION is the undersaddle portion of Class #12 - Open Ride and Drive.

Cantering on the premises at any time will result in elimination from the entire event.

Unruly horses will be excused from the ring.

10. Bridles

UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES OR CONDITION SHOULD A BRIDLE BE REMOVED FROM A HORSE/PONY WHILE IT IS STILL PUT TO A VEHICLE. Bridles should fit snugly to prevent catching on a vehicle or other pieces of harness.

11. Breakdown

In the event of breakdown in a class, either to harness or vehicle, which necessitates halt for repair, the competitor is to make only those adjustments/repairs necessary for the safe removal of their turnout from the class.

GENERAL

12. Breed and size

The pleasure driving horse may be of any breed, colour, or size, including donkeys, mules, miniatures and draft. All animals must be three years of age or over, and be in good physical condition. An animal measuring over 14 hands will be classified as a horse. An animal measuring 14 hands and under will be classified as a pony for this event.

13. Junior Driver

A junior driver is a competitor (in this event) who has reached their 12 birthday and not have passed their 18th birthday as of January 1st of the current year. For show purposes the age of an individual on January 1 shall be maintained throughout the entire year. IT IS REQUIRED THAT AN ADULT ACCOMPANY EACH JUNIOR DRIVER.

14. Judge's Decision

A Judges decision, representing his individual preference, is not protestable unless it is alleged to be in violation of the rules.

15. Animal Height

A protest with respect to the height of a horse or pony may only be made to the Show Committee of the show. Re-measurement shall take place immediately.

16. Soundness of Animal

The opinion of the official veterinarian of the show, concerning the soundness of an unsound horse or pony is not protestable.

17. Ribbons will be awarded to fourth place.

18. No stabling on grounds, pens allowed.

Horse trailer parking is available on grounds.

Non serviced camping available on grounds.

19. Please note that this schedule is tentative and will be finalized depending on entries.
